

Orange County Auditor-Controller's Office Announces Publication of 2017-18 Financial Reports

Orange County Auditor-Controller Eric H. Woolery is pleased to announce the publication of this year's <u>Annual Comprehensive Accounting Financial Report (CAFR)</u> and its accompanying <u>Citizen's Report</u>. This year's reports highlighted the District Attorney's office with the theme of "Justice".

The CAFR is the audited financial statement for the County's prior fiscal year. It is designed to fairly present the financial position as well as changes in the financial position of the County. Every year the Auditor-Controller releases the CAFR for the prior fiscal year ending June 30.



The document is prepared in accordance with Sections 25250 and 25253 of the Government Code of the State of California. An outside auditing firm is retained to audit the report.

Along with the CAFR, the Auditor-Controller prepares a common language Citizens' Financial Report, also known as the Popular Annual Financial Report (PAFR), which summarizes key aspects of the CAFR in layman's terms. In addition, we seek input from community groups and leaders to target information that they believe may be of particular interest to the public.
