**Orange County Auditor-Controller Releases Annual Citizens Report  
for Fiscal Year 2024-2025**

**Santa Ana, CA** - The Orange County Auditor-Controller's Office has released this year's Popular Annual Financial Report (PAFR) for Fiscal Year 2024-2025. Known as the Citizens' Report, the PAFR is a summarized guide to the County's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report (ACFR), presenting financial information from the fiscal year that began July 1, 2024 and ended June 30, 2025.

The Citizens' Report is an important resource that provides valuable insight into how public funds are managed and allocated to serve Orange County residents. By presenting complex financial information in an easy-to-understand format, the report promotes transparency and helps foster trust in County operations. It highlights major financial achievements, strategic investments, and ongoing efforts to ensure accountability to the community.

Each year, the Auditor-Controller's Office selects a County agency to feature as part of the report's theme. This year's report spotlights Human Resource Services and the crucial role the department plays in supporting employees, attracting and retaining talent, and reinforcing the County's long-term fiscal and operational strength.

"This year's Citizens' Report demonstrates our continued commitment to responsible financial stewardship and to the people who make County government work," said Andrew Hamilton, Orange County Auditor-Controller.
